

Astrology

The word Astrology is also a code. Astro... knowledge; Astro rearranged is Sator which means savior, and also Rotas which means wheel. The Tarot deck from Ancient India was called Rotas. The wheel is the cosmic man known as the Purusha of the Zodiac. The Rotas (Tarot) cards are the ten planets and 12 signs of the Zodiac, along with the four decks for the four elements that also relate to the placement of the Rotas, in other words the wheel of the Zodiac. The ancients knew about the ten planets, you can note this on Sumerian artifacts.

The enemy loves to claim the Tarot is from the Jewish Kabala. They are not, they were stolen.

"Gypsies, as most people realize did not come from Egypt but rather India. It begins to sound plausible that perhaps the Gypsies brought cards from India to Europe in their wanderings, especially considering the fact that playing cards were known among the Indians. These cards were broken into different numbers of suits than the European decks that exist, which almost always have four suits, however, the gods depicted on the Indian cards sometimes held a cup, coin, sword, and scepter one in each of the god's four hands, suggesting a possible relationship between these Indian cards and the European suit signs. In relation to the theory that Gypsies brought the Indian cards to Europe, Tilley writes, 'This theory is no longer tenable since it is now known that cards were established in Europe before the gipsy advance-guard reached the eastern approaches.'" Later at some point the enemy corrupted this with their Hebrew kabbalah. The enemy church also condemned the Tarot as the Devil's game. The reason the Pagan New Year is March 21 is due to the Sun entering Aries, this is the date to begin the Magnum Opus. This gives the clue to the letter Gera, known as Yeram in the ancient runes. This is the letter of Aries, The Ram, which starts the wheel of the year which Jeram, Yeram, Gera also symbolize in the runic letters. Aries is the Ram, and Ram is also the mantra of this symbol in the east and west. The Lamb is of Aries as well, which was stolen into the Agnus Dei, known as the Lamb of God. This originally was Agni Dev, the symbol of the God Agni, the head god of Rome later known as Janus. There are still ancient frescoes of Pagan Roman Priests dressed in the same way as Hindu Brahmans from India and doing the same Vedic fire altar rituals to Agni that they still do in Hindu India. The Agnus Dei is shown with the symbol relating to the 7 main chakras:



The symbol the Angus Dei is showing is the use of the mantra RA or RAM. This mantra is to be vibrated into the chakras, shown in the above picture with the solar cross on them. The symbol denotes this with the chariot of RA meditation, which HPS Maxine has posted on the JoS. This is ancient, from Egypt, and done by Yogis in Hindu India as an important meditation. This is the birth of the new soul, which starts on this date (March 21). The symbol of each chakra in the Angus Dei is the symbol of the fifth rune of Ra (Raidho) which is the chariot wheel, the wheels being the chakras. "Chakra" meaning "wheel of RA". The chakras are called "the seven souls of RA" in Egypt.

The Sator ("the savior") is the Magnum Opus, which is based on the knowledge of Astrology and how it ties into the soul. The 72 of the enemy comes from the Zodiac. The Templars called it "the number of Man" because it is the number of the wheel of the year. The Zodiac is the cosmic man. The Jews stole this with their "Adam Kadmon". The 72 relates to the decans and the four quadrants, each getting 18 and thus adding up to 72. The Greeks and the Egyptians also had this in their religions where the Jews stole this from.

The 24 Greek letters of the alphabet were divided up into the Soma Sophia, the body of the Zodiac, for their use in the Opus. The enemy stole this and corrupted it in the book of Revelations; the 24 Elders before the Throne of God was originally a Greek allegory: the 24 Gods (the letters) sitting before the throne

which was the IAO of Zeus. Each letter was a Pagan Greek Deity and also had longer mantras of each letter based on the Deity it ruled which included the open titles of the deity. The Hebrew Teth letter was stolen from the Greek and Egyptian God name Thoth which is also a letter. The Jews just changed out the vowel.
